Policy 921 Master's Degree

Scope

This Policy on Master's Degree applies to students ("Covered Individuals") of The Graduate School of the Stowers Institute for Medical Research ("School").

Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to establish the conditions under which a student can pursue a master's degree.

Policy

The School recruits, admits, and enrolls students exclusively for the Ph.D. program. The School does not recruit, admit, or enroll students whose primary objective is a master's degree. However, in certain cases, the School will confer a Master's of Science (M.S.) degree in Biology to students who, for various reasons and circumstances, elect not to complete the Ph.D. degree. Circumstances under which a student could revise their enrollment include, but are not limited to, changes in marital status; changes in parental status; caretaking of a parent, sibling, spouse or child; health issues; and other life changing events.

Students must meet with and receive written permission from their Supervisory Committee, in consultation with the Dean, prior to pursing a master's degree, as outlined in Protocol 1029 (Master's Degree).
